Send The Boss An Email That Gets Results

Your boss is busy. Sending an email might be more efficient than waiting until you can schedule a meeting, but how can you make sure your manager will read it and respond? Stick to these basics:

- ★ Get to the point. Short emails are easier to read, digest, and act on. Don't waste time with irrelevant details. Be polite, but dive right into the subject.
- ★ Define the outcome you're looking for. Tell the boss exactly what you want to do (or what you want him or her to do). If you need a decision, ask for it explicitly. If you have a plan, ask for a direct yes-orno response.
- ★ Use the subject line. Tell your boss what the email is about at the top. A subject line like "Decision needed on Smith project" prepares him or her to address the subject right away.
- ★ Don't pester. Before sending that email, consider whether someone else can help you. If you're asking your supervisor for assistance all the time, he or she will doubt your ability, or maybe start ignoring your messages.



Simple Tips To Protect Your Vision At Work

For more and more of us, "work" means staring at a computer screen all day, and that can have an impact on your eyes. Protect your vision on the job by following this basic eye care advice:

- ✓ **Get regular eye exams.** Visit your eye doctor once a year to check your vision for any problems.
- ✓ **Position your screen.** Place your computer monitor 20-26 inches away from your eyes, and a little below eye level.
- ✓ Get a document holder. If you need to refer to printed documents as you work, hang a holder next to your monitor so you don't constantly have to refocus your eyes as you look back and forth.
- ✓ **Adjust text size.** Set your computer to display text at a level that's easy to read without straining.
- ✓ Use the right lighting. Avoid glare and strong reflections on your monitor with soft lighting that won't damage your eyes.

ER Vs. Clinic: Which To Choose?

Hospital emergency rooms are stretched thin by almost 136 million visits a year. Many of these visits are triggered by complaints that could be handled more efficiently at same-day clinics or pharmacy care centers. How do you know which to choose?

Go to the emergency room (or call an ambulance) if you or a friend experience any of these serious symptoms:

- Persistent chest pain
- Persistent shortness of breath
- Severe pain, especially in the abdomen or the lower back
- Loss of balance or fainting
- Difficulty speaking or thinking clearly
- ▶ Sudden, severe headache

On the other hand, most **same-day clinics** are able to treat these routine health problems:

- Minor trauma such as cuts and sprains
- Severe sore throat
- Nausea and vomiting

A clinic will also be able to advise you to go to the emergency room if your condition is more serious than you realize.



Hold A 'Pitch Day' To Stimulate New Ideas

If you want to encourage an atmosphere of innovation and entrepreneurship in your organization, try what others have done—hold a regular "pitch day" for employees to suggest projects and ideas to senior management. Urge them to cross team boundaries and work together with co-workers from other departments in developing ideas. Choose the best projects for implementation, at least on a pilot basis. You'll generate lots of ideas, and enhance teamwork in your organization as well.

Start Dental Health Early

Dental health is important to even the youngest children. Do your best to keep your kids' teeth clean and healthy by following these basics:

- ◆ Brush and floss every day. Teach your kids how to brush their teeth and floss properly. When children are very young (up to age 6 or 7) brush their teeth for them for two minutes a day.
- ◆ Provide a healthy diet. Give kids foods and beverages that are low in sugar (which contributes to tooth decay). Limit snacks.
- ◆ Be careful with bottles and sippy cups. Keep sippy cups at the table, and don't let children walk around with them. This will help you control the level of sugar they consume in drinks.
- ◆ Get regular checkups. Take your children to the dentist twice a year for an exam and cleaning. This sets the stage for good dental health throughout their lives.



Reward The Right Behavior

When reviewing employee performance, remember to focus on the behavior you really want to support. For example, punctuality: Who's more valuable to your organization—a worker who's always on time but does only the bare minimum, or an employee who's sometimes a few minutes late but does excellent work? If punctuality and quality get equal attention, you may not be reinforcing the behavior you really need. Take a look at your process with an eye toward targeting what's really valuable.



Parenting Advice: Can You Trust The Experts?

- → **Listen to your gut.** Decide whether or not a parenting class or advice book fits your intuition. If it doesn't jibe, don't feel pressured into following it verbatim.
- **Be patient.** Be skeptical of any advice that seems to promise quick fixes.
- **→ Don't hang on too long.** Be willing to try worthwhile advice out, but drop it if it isn't working.
- → Check advisors' credentials. Whether you're taking a parenting seminar or buying a book, check out the credentials of the experts.

Don't Assume The Other Driver Will Stop After A Crash

After a crash you are momentarily stunned. You pull over and ask your passengers if they are ok and get out of the car to be sure everyone in the other vehicle is ok. AAA recommends the following tips to be sure your insurance claim will go smoothly. Be aware the driver may take off and drive away.

- Pull over safely and write down as much information as possible-license plate#, what driver looks like, color and make of the vehicle & any damage. Take pictures of the vehicle & area if possible, All if safe & possible to do so.
- If any witnesses, write down their contact information and testimony to what they witnessed.
- Call the Police and report the accident to your insurer.
- If the driver is caught fines are up to \$10,000.00 and possible prison time.
