Keep Children Safe In And Around Your Car

- ✓ **Don't play around parked cars.** Never let your children run around or play in a parking lot. In your driveway, make sure your car's motor is off before letting children out. Always check around your car before starting up to leave.
- ✓ **Practice basic safety.** Hold their hands in parking lots and crossing the street. Make sure they know to stop and look both ways before stepping forward into the street.
- ✓ **Be careful with locks and windows.** Automatic locks can trap children inside your car. Power windows can cause injuries.
- ✓ **Don't leave kids in hot cars.** Cars can heat up quickly in any weather, even with the windows cracked. Don't leave your kids alone in a parked car for any reason.



Keep Your Fireplace Safe This Winter

The winter months are perfect for snuggling up in front of a nice cozy fire. Just make sure your fireplace doesn't pose a hazard to your home with these tips from the Hearth, Patio & Barbecue Association:

- ▶ Clear the area around the fireplace and chimney. Debris too close to your fireplace can ignite.
- ▶ Always use a fireplace screen.
- ▶ Don't overload your fireplace with logs.
- ▶ Don't try to burn your Christmas tree or other refuse in your fireplace.
- ▶ Always keep a fire extinguisher nearby.
- ▶ Equip your home with smoke detectors and check your batteries on a regular basis.
- ▶ Place your logs on a grate at the rear of your fireplace.
- ▶ Never leave the fire unattended. Make sure the fire is fully extinguished before you go to bed.
- ▶ Keep fireplace wood stacked, covered and out of doors—away from the house and off the ground.
- ▶ Have your fireplace and flue inspected and cleaned annually by a certified chimney sweep.



Mystery Of The Missing Moon

The planet Saturn poses many puzzles for astronomers—not just its mysterious rings, but its odd tilt as it spins on its axis. Now, the Science News website reports, scientists believe both phenomena may have the same cause—a missing moon.

Saturn has 83 moons. Astronomers theorize that it may have had at least one more, which they've dubbed Chrysalis. For billions of years, Saturn was locked in gravitational synch with the neighboring planet Neptune. Then, about 160 million years ago, Chrysalis's orbit became unstable, causing it to drift too close to the planet. Ultimately the gravitational stress pulled the moon apart. Most of it fell down into Saturn, but some of it stayed in orbit, breaking into smaller chunks that eventually formed Saturn's iconic rings. The loss of the moon also may have pulled Saturn out of reach of Neptune's gravity, resulting in its current rotational tilt.

The explanation relies on simulations of Saturn's orbital dynamics going back in time. The existence and destruction of Chrysalis, which would have been about the size of Saturn's third largest moon Iapetus, could account for both Saturn's rings and its tilt, solving a longstanding astronomical mystery.



Try These Tips For Working Better

Want to be more effective at work? Try these tips from the book *Are You Fully Charged?* by Tom Rath (Silicon Guild):

- **Focus for 45 minutes, then take a break.** You can't work full out for eight hours straight. Train yourself to concentrate on one task for 45 minutes or so, then take a break of 15 minutes before diving back in.
- **Spark conversations with questions.** You'll learn more about people and their jobs by asking them questions instead of just talking constantly about what you do.

When Did Mammals Turn Warm-Blooded?

Mammals today are warm-blooded, but that wasn't always the case. Our most distant ancestors were cold-blooded, and scientists have long wondered when the shift took place.

Now, according to the Live Science website, scientists believe they know just when warm-blooded mammals evolved, and it's all because of an analysis of the inner ear.

A fluid called endolymph travels through the canals of the inner ear, transmitting messages that help the body stay balanced. The fluid is thicker in cold-blooded mammals, so they have wider canals to accommodate it, but in warm-blooded animals, endolymph is thinner, so ear canals are narrower. Scientists studied the ear canals of 341 animals, 64 of them extinct, and discovered the general era when mammals began developing warm blood and thinner ear canals—some 233 million years ago.

That's 19 million years later than scientists had previously believed, and the change appears to have happened rapidly, at the same approximate time that mammals began growing whiskers, fur, and backbones.
